- Total Budget approved in 2017-2018: Rs 5,633 crore
- Per-student SSA Expenditure for FY 2016-2017: Rs 3,549 against an all-India figure of Rs 4,387
- Elementary Enrolment (Govt): 75,20,779 in 2016-2017 which dropped from 99,13,184 in 2012-13
- 67% of approved budget for Learning Enhancement Programme* (LEP) spent in 2016-2017
- National Achievement Survey score in Math: 52 per cent class 5 students scored below 50% in year 2017
