

# DO SCHOOLS GET THEIR MONEY?

## PAISA NATIONAL REPORT 2014

Since 2010, Accountability Initiative, Centre for Policy Research, has been implementing a series of studies called PAISA that track plans, budgets and fund flows in elementary education. The studies include a national level survey undertaken through the annual ASER survey. The ASER survey is facilitated by Pratham. The 2014 PAISA National Report is based on data collected from 15,206 schools across the country. The ASER survey is implemented entirely by citizen volunteers and civil society organisations. This makes the PAISA National Report the first and only national level citizen led effort to track development









### DO SCHOOLS GET GRANTS?

Development Grant (%)




### WHEN DO SCHOOLS GET GRANTS?

### WHAT DO SCHOOLS SPEND THEIR GRANTS ON?




### WHEN DID THE SMC LAST MEET?
